

## **Thompson Health Career Exploration Day Dress Code**

Camp attendees are expected to maintain a professional appearance while at camp. ***Below are general guidelines:***

- Identification badges will be provided and must be visible and worn at all times when at the camp.
- Clothing must be clean and neat.
- No miniskirts, halter-tops, short shorts, tube tops, spaghetti straps, tight fitting or revealing attire (no waist/midriff exposed).
- No sweatpants. The hospital recommends that students wear khaki pants, but if they are not available jeans or light-weight pants are acceptable.

- Hair clean and neat.
- Jewelry limited. Please avoid large dangling earrings.
- No hats.
- No heavy perfume or cologne.

- Please don't bring valuable items and money. A secure place for personal items will not be available.
