 Construction Update: The classroom is almost complete, and now serving as our break room while the break room is renovated. The break room will be finished, hopefully, by the 15<sup>th</sup>. We are installing vinyl floor instead of carpet.

We will be starting on the hallways and patient rooms very soon. This will require patience and happy faces as we enter the stage of construction that will really impact us. I will be posting the staging of the different areas of the unit so you will all know what is coming next. At some point we will be moving the Nursery and the Nurses' Station into patient rooms while those areas are renovated.
